Ideally located in the northwest of the Saint-Julien appellation, Château Moulin Riche is composed of 20 hectares of vineyard forming a single block. From this terroir are born wines that are delectable, yet still echoing the elegant, structured style of the appellation.

2021 will be remembered as a year of courage. A quality that guided our teams in the face of the increasingly unpredictable nature of the vintage. They were able to stay the course with their high standards, while at the same time accepting to follow their intuition and to take risks. All came well as they savored the pleasure of making this vintage fresher than the previous three, and allowed themselves to become enchanted by the purity of the fruit and its elegance.

90-92 La RVF - mai 2022

Le vin se montre charmeur, avec un fruit charnu, bien mûr, et un côté suave en bouche. Il est porté par des tanins arrondis, à la limite de la pointe de sucrosité.

89-91 Yves Beck, Beckustator - mai 2022

Le bouquet de Moulin Riche révèle discrètement son élevage auquel s'ajoutent des nuances de mûres et de garrigues. Le vin est friand et bien tenu par des tannins juteux, légèrement suaves. Ils offrent une bonne assise tandis que la structure se charge de la fraîcheur. Un vin de caractère.

92 Decanter; Georgina Hindle - May 2022

Red fruits, strawberries, red cherries, plums, raspberries and perfume - such an explosion of aromatics. Delicacy in terms of texture and overall appeal, it has an excellent balance between fine but filling tannins, acidity and the plush cool blue fruit. Sculpted, chewy and mouthfilling yet well restrained. It's muscular in a sense but also charming at the same time with succulence and liquorice, clove and saline touches on the end showing the markings of the terroir. I love it.

91-93 Antonio Galloni, Vinous Media - May 2022

The 2021 Moulin Riche is a dark, racy Saint-Julien. Black cherry, plum, spice, new leather, tobacco, menthol and licorice are all dialed up in a generous, inviting 2021 that has much to offer. There's lovely upfront intensity here. I would prefer to drink this succulent, yet mid-weight Saint-Julien over the next decade or so.

There is a considerable difference between this lovely wine and the other two from the L-P stable. The Petit Verdot content and the darker soils bring a deepness and richness to the flavour. While the fruit complexity is not as varied nor as plush as those found in the Poyferré wines themselves, there is undoubtedly a lot of interest and focus here. But alongside this depth of flavour, there is no added tannin, nor is there any hard acidity. This is a massive success for Moulin Riche, and those seeking a full-flavoured, gastronomically-pleasing wine at a great price need look no further.

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
